

VMware vSphere 7.0: Support deadline extended

VMware by Broadcom has postponed the originally planned End of General Support (EoGS) date for vSphere 7.0 from 2 April 2025 by six months. The new deadline is now 2 October 2025. This gives businesses more time to prepare for upgrading to a newer version.

The extension gives you extra time to plan your upgrade to vSphere 8.0. Until 2 October 2025, support and security updates will still be available – after that, only paid support options will be offered.
